IED Awareness and Defeat Training

Improvised Explosive Devices (IED) are currently the leading cause of casualties to troops deployed in Iraq. These make-shift bombs are being used by terrorists in menacing new ways to destroy property and lives. Integrating IED Defeat training into urban and convoy simulations helps War fighters obtain improved performance on the battlefield and, most importantly, prevents the loss of life.

The (5) day Military Pre Deployment Training course focuses on enhancing the survivability of the operator while engaged in SOF operations in both urban and rural environments. This course was developed in response to the threat of insurgent activities in Iraq and Afghanistan, although the principles of the instruction apply to any high threat operating environment.

Through realistic scenarios, the instruction in Medical procedures, Firearms and Tactics deals with the physiological and psychological aspects of combat to reduce hesitation. This allows correct response to initial contact and maximizes the options available to the team for enhanced survivability. The training also provides opportunity to evaluate response under worst-case conditions such as limited ammunition, small isolated groups of operators (2-4 personnel), wounded team-members, and lack of immediate support.
